By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Section	Police Station
25	01.03.2024	406 and 420 of IPC	Sector-9, Ambala City, District Ambala

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 04.04.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 04.04.2024.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amar Singh intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial investigation.
4. During the course of hearing on 04.04.2024, following order

was passed:



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“Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Ramesh Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQS, District Ambala has been filed respectively. The same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel opposite.

At this stage, Mr. Babbar Bhan, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant in CRM-M-15594-2024 and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Upon request made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter is adjourned to 10.07.2024.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner(s) be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner(s) shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the connected cases.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 04.04.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 04.04.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; she will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.



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6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not
be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
