NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing Annexure P-10 and P-11, vide which the respondents have denied to fix the pension/retiral benefits of the petitioner on the last pay drawn i.e. Rs.8550/- per month and have fixed the same @ Rs.8100/- per month.

2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing, therefore, notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner for today.

3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that the petitioner has died.

4. Learned State counsel, submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has unfortunately died on 19.06.2009.



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5. Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner and his LRs have also not been brought on record, therefore, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the LRs of the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
