1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.264 dated 09.08.2023, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Line Sonapat, District Sonapat (Annexure P-1).

2. Vide order dated 17.05.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, an amount of Rs. 6.25 lacs was deposited in the bank account of the petitioner. In order to show his bonafide, the petitioner was ready to deposit the requisite amount and, therefore he was granted time to do the needful. Subsequently, on the last date of hearing i.e. on 18.07.2024 he had sought extension of time to comply with order dated 17.05.2024 and, accordingly, he was granted time and the matter was adjourned for today.

Today again, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



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petitioner is unable to deposit the requisite amount.

4. In view of the submissions made above, the petition is dismissed, for non-compliance of order dated 17.05.2024.
