VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, direction or order directing respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to fix the seniority of the petitioner in the rank of Assistant Sub Inspector of Police.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to the year 1996 and the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inspite of the best efforts, he has not been able to get in touch with the petitioner and hence, he prays that the present petition may be dismissed for non-

prosecution at this stage but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case any cause of action survives in the same.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
