By way of present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for his release on regular bail in a case arising out of FIR No.780 dated 25.10.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 379B, 427 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat.

2. Allegations are that on 24.10.2023 at about 8 p.m., complainant was driving a bus bearing registration No.UP-15FT-3183, when he was overtaken by another bus bearing registration No.UP-22T-8975 being driven by Aagaj, besides a Wagnor car and an Innova car. About 10-15 persons armed with lathis and dandas alighted from these vehicles, broke the glasses of the bus being driven by the complainant and caused injuries to conductor and the driver. It is further alleged that they also gave injuries on passenger Tinku and took away ₹2,200/- from his pocket.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that there is no specific attribution to him; that he is not named in the FIR; that he is in custody for the last more than 04 months; and that the trial may take time to conclude and so he be allowed bail.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Gagandeep Singh Chhina, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
6. Learned State counsel has placed on record custody certificate, revealing that petitioner is in custody for the last 04 months and 13 days. He has no other criminal case pending against him.
7. Learned State counsel concedes the fact that there is no specific attribution to the petitioner.
8. Having regard to all the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
