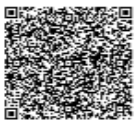

Short reply by way of affidavit of Shri Shamsheer Singh, PPS,
Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Faridkot has been filed on
behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for
quashing of FIR No.39 dated 28.05.2023, under Sections 307, 324, 148, 149
and 506 of IPC (later on added Section 326 of IPC), registered at Police
Station Sadiq Faridkot, District Faridkot and all subsequent proceedings
arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 06.03.2024 (Annexure
P-2).

This Court vide order dated 03.04.2024 had directed the parties
to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the
learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the
compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before
Sessions Judge, Faridkot their statements recorded. On the basis of the



statements so recorded, Learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 06.05.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.39 dated 28.05.2023, under Sections 307, 324, 148, 149 and 506 of IPC (later on added Section 326 of IPC), registered at Police Station Sadiq Faridkot, District Faridkot and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 06.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
