1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for providing proper medical treatment to Rinku @ Rinki son of the petitioner, who is confined in District Jail, Panipat.
2. A status report by way of an affidavit of Superintendent District jail, Panipat has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
3. In the status report, the following averments have been made, which is reproduced as under:-

“That, as per medical report submitted by the Medical Officer, District Jail, Panipat:-

“Certified that Rinku S/o Maha Singh is a known case of Diabetes Mellitus and Pulmonary Tuberculosis. Patient is on regular A.T.T. (Anti Tuberculosis Treatment). Patient was complaining pain in right ear on examination it is diagnosed as cyst in right ear for which patient was sent to Civil Hospital, Panipat on

dated 10.07.2023 for ENT opinion where patient treated accordingly. Later on patient was complaining of Blood in cough for which patient was sent to Civil Hospital, Panipat on 02.03.2024, 05.03.2024 and 07.03.2024 for Chest and T.B Department where some blood and sputum investigations were done and patient diagnosed as suffering with Pulmonary Tuberculosis and Anti Tuberculosis Treatment started. On dated 20.03.2024 patient was sent to Civil Hospital, Panipat regarding uncontrolled Blood Sugar where patient treated as per advise. Later on as per order of Hon'ble High Court patient was sent to Civil Hospital on urgent basis on dated 02.04.2024 for Medical Examination by Medical Board where a Medical Board was established with members (Dr. Sukhdeep Kaur Emergency Physician, Dr. Jasmine Kaur Physician and Dr. Pardeep Kumar Orthopedic Surgeon).

As per medical Board report patient is a known case of Diabetes Mellitus and Pulmonary Tuberculosis sputum positive, on ATT

- 1. Patient has complains of chest pain and recurrent hemoptysis. On examination patient is conscious oriented and has tachycardia PR-135 bpm, BP-104/80 and SpO2 on room air 94%. Patient requires pulmonogist opinion for recurrent hemoptysis.*
- 2. ECG done reveals a HR of 138bpm, sinus tachycardia with T-wave inversion in leads III and V3, V4 which needs further evaluation by a cardiologist.*
- 3. Patient has a blood sugar level of 285 mg/dl, and in view of uncontrolled Blood Sugar levels and to rule out Insulin dependent DM further consultation with endocrinologist as advised.*
- 4. Thus board is of the opinion that patient needs admission at Higher centre for Cardiologist, endocrinologist and pulmonologist opinion and further management.*

And patient was referred to Pt. B.D Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak where patient still admitted (Ti66 Dated 05.04.2024). (Medical report enclosed as Annexure R-3)."

4. In view of the affidavit filed by Superintendent, District Jail, Panipat no further directions are required and the petition, is accordingly disposed off.
