1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing notice dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) issued by Tehsildar-cum-Executive Magistrate, Jalandhar-1, pursuant to order dated 18.01.2023 passed by Additional District Magistrate, Jalandhar whereby residential house/secured asset of petitioners was ordered to be taken into possession.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.1, on instructions from Mr. Ajay Sharma, Deputy Manager, Legal submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioners' account has been regularised/made standard, though petitioners are in default of one installment.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that she does not have any instructions in the matter as petitioners have not contacted her.

4. Be that as it may, in view of the categorical statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.1, we find no justification for continuation of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous without expression of any opinion on merits of the matter or even entertainability thereof. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioners are at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
