Status report dated 09.05.2024 by way of an affidavit of Shri
Vipan Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division
Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-
State and the same is taken on record.

On 01.04.2024, following order was passed:

*“By way of present petition filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.0014 dated 25.01.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at
Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the
matter has since been compromised amongst the parties vide
Annexure P.1 and that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.*

Notice of motion.

*Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on
behalf of the respondent- State. Copy of the petition be supplied to
him during course of the day.*

Adjourned to 09.05.2024 for filing status report.

In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall

be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dildar Singh submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 01.04.2024 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
