1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents to hand over the investigation of FIR No.245 dated 20.12.2023 under Sections 376 & 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka, to some senior officer.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner is a divorcee and she met respondent No.4 in the year 2014. On the pretext of marriage, respondent No.4 established physical relations with the petitioner and thereafter, she came to know that he is already married and he has cheated her and his wife. The petitioner broke up her relationship with respondent No.4 and on 10.09.2023, respondent No.4 visited the petitioner and

forced himself upon her and also threatened that he will leak her video, in case she disclose this fact to anyone.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and on instructions from ASI Ranjeet Singh, submits that veracity of the allegations levelled by the petitioner were thoroughly investigated by the investigating agency and the same are found to be false and cancellation report in the FIR (*supra*) has been prepared, which is approved by the police authorities and would be submitted before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate within a period of four weeks from today.

5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, no directions are required to be issued in the present petition. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to invoke the alternative remedy as available to her, in accordance with law.

6. The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
