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HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the benefit of arrears on account of retrospective regularization of service has not been given to him and that too without any valid justification. Learned counsel submits that once the petitioner has been granted the benefit of regularization from the year 2003, the petitioner is entitled for all the consequential benefit including arrears along with interest @ 18%.
2. Learned counsel submits that the grievance raised before this Court has already been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 21.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case the benefit is given to the petitioner by passing an appropriate order.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.
5. If the legal notice for deciding the claim of the petitioner has been received and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of 8

weeks from the receipt of the copy of this order, and in case, it is found feasible to extend the relief, the same will be extended to the petitioner otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the same.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having being not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
