1. Instant third petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in:-

2. During the course of arguments, counsel for the parties have apprised the Court that out of 14 prosecution witnesses, 3 have been given up and 10 witnesses have been examined. The 14th prosecution witness has been examined-in-chief and his cross-examination is yet to be done.

2. Noticing the advance stage of the trial, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer made in the petition. However, since the petitioner is in detention since the last more than 2 ½ years, trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude it as expeditiously as possible.
