KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition cast under Section 439(2) of the Cr.P.C., a prayer is made for cancellation of anticipatory bail, granted by this Court to respondent no.2, vide order dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-1), in case FIR No.427, dated 16.06.2023, under Sections 323, 365, 384, 419, 506, 34 and 342 of the IPC.
2. While referring to the representation (Annexure P-4), learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent no.2-accused, is now extending threats to the petitioner to implicate him in a false case. Therefore, it is a clear cut violations of the terms and conditions, on which respondent no.2, was extended the relief of anticipatory bail.

3. Without issuing notice of motion, Mr.Yogesh Jangra, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of respondent No.2, through a validly executed power of attorney in his favour. The same is taken on record. He denied the submissions as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. This Court has put a pinpoint query to learned counsel for the petitioner, to the effect that, whether, the representation (Annexure P-4), was ever examined by the competent authority concerned, and whether, the allegations levelled in the representation were found to be correct, to which he answered in 'negative'.

5. Further, this Court has also gone through the entire petition and finds, no other relevant evidence to conclude that respondent no.2, is in fact, misutilising the concession of anticipatory bail.

6. In view of the above, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.

7. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
