GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners-Akashdeep Singh, Gurbax Singh and Yuvraj Singh Waraich has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.100, dated 19.5.2023, Police Station PS Gobindgarh Mandi, Fatehgarh Sahib, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), and all subsequent proceedings emanating



therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 08.04.2024, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Amloh, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statement of petitioners/accused Akashdeep Singh, Gurbax Singh (minor) through his natural guardian Sikander Singh, Yuvraj Singh Waraich (minor) through his natural guardian Jagjit Singh and complainant Krishna Pandey (minor) through his natural guardian Manoj Pandey have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
4. Complainant Krishna Pandey (minor) through his natural guardian Manoj Pandey in his statement had stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Amloh, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition

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is allowed and FIR No.100, dated 19.5.2023, Police Station PS Gobindgarh Mandi, Fatehgarh Sahib, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
