The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *certiorari* for setting aside the order dated 14.03.2023 issued by Respondent No.4, vide which the petitioner has been retired w.e.f. 31.03.2023 on his attaining the age of 60 years and further a writ of *mandamus* has been sought seeking direction to the respondents to grant benefit of extension to the petitioner in the retirement age i.e. from 60 years to 62 years.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order dated 05.03.2024 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal no.3820 of 2024 arising out of SLP (Civil) No.25816 of 2018 in case titled as 'Punjab Urban Planning and Development Authority through its Additional Chief Administrator versus Swaran Singh Jawanda and others', no further cause survives in the present petition, therefore, she wishes to withdraw the present petition. Copy of the abovesaid order is taken on record.
