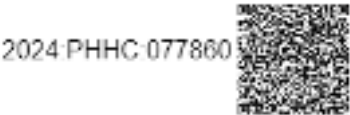

1. The police official ASI Mahinder Pal, Police Station, Tibber, has come to assist the learned State counsel. On a Court question, he is unable to answer any question. He is unaware of the number of prosecution witnesses summoned for 15.07.2024, i.e the next date of hearing before the trial court. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur is directed to file an affidavit explaining the reasons for deputing an official to the court who lacks knowledge of the case.

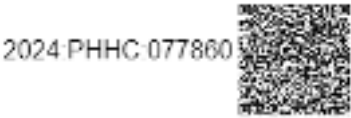
2. This is the petitioner's 6th attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR no.23 dated 20.04.2017 registered under Sections 302, 307, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149 120B, 201, 212, 216 IPC of 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at P.S.Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

3. At the request of the Court, a status report in the form of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police City, District Gurdaspur



has been filed, enlisting as many as 17 criminal cases, pending or decided against the petitioner. The list reads as under:-

4. Keeping in view the petitioner’s antecedents, this Court is not inclined to grant him bail.

5. Hence, the bail application is dismissed.

6. However, the trial court is directed to make sincere endeavours for expeditious disposal of the case. It shall be the responsibility of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to ensure the presence of the prosecution witnesses as and when summoned by the court. In case of any default, the same shall be treated with the utmost seriousness.

7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
