1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 08.02.2012 and 31.07.2013 passed in RSA-554-2012.
2. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, as well as, the nature of the order itself, for determination of contempt qua that order; a lot of disputed questions would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudication of the disputed questions of fact would not even be appropriate in the contempt proceedings. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
3. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, if they have any grievance qua the property involved in the case.
