JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider his candidature sympathetically.

2. The petitioner pursuant to advertisement applied for the post of Constable (G.D.) in C.R.P.F. He was selected and appointment letter dated 10.02.2021 (Annexure P-1) was issued to him. He was directed to join on 15.03.2021, however, he failed to report. By letter dated 19.03.2021 (Annexure P-2), he was again asked to join on 14.04.2021 but he did not join. Left with no other option, respondent vide letter dated 30.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) cancelled appointment letter of the petitioner. The petitioner approached respondent to consider him in July, 2021 and thereafter approached this Court in April 2022.

3. Mr. Kewal Krishan, Advocate submits that respondent may

be directed to consider petitioner’s case sympathetically. He undertakes that if respondent considers his case in one or another way, he would not again approach this Court because he has no right in law or equity.

4. Mr. S.K. Sharma, Sr. Panel Counsel submits that there was no lapse or fault on the part of respondent. Petitioner himself opted not to join post, nevertheless, the competent authority would re-consider his claim subject to his aforesaid undertaking.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
