1. In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioners is that some of the posts which are lying vacant have been blocked by the respondents so as to allow the petitioners to opt for the same while effecting annual transfers.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that certain posts on which new recruitment has been made, has to be treated as vacant as per the transfer policy, which is not being done by the respondents hence, respondents are under an obligation to grant the said benefit to the petitioners as being sought in the present petition.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 05.12.2023 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the

respondents to decide the said representation.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 05.12.2023 (Annexure P/6) has been received from the petitioners and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioners, the same will be extended to them otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioners will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioners.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
8. Ordered accordingly.
