1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.6 to 12.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Paramjeet Samota, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Assandh, District Karnal has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. The same is taken on record.
3. The stand of the State has been culled out in para Nos.4 and 5 which reads as under:-

“4. That as regards the threat perception against the petitioners is concerned, an inquiry was conducted by the police through A.S.I. Sanjay and H.C. Karambir; who recorded the statements of Balbir Singh s/o Mange, Roshni Devi w/o Balbir, who are father and mother of petitioner Neha and also respondents No. 6 & 7 respectively in the present petition. Besides it, the joint statement of petitioners Neha and Pragat Singh was also recorded by A.S.I. Sanjay, wherein,

they have categorically stated that now there is no danger to their life and they wants to go out of the Safe House, Karnal. The statement of Balbir Singh, Roshni and joint statement of Neha and Pragat Singh are annexed herewith as **Annexure R-2 to R-4** respectively for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

5. That the Inquiry Officer has also reported that there is no danger to life and liberty to the petitioners and the petitioners may be allowed to leave the Safe House and the S.H.O./respondent No. 3 has agreed accordingly with the report of A.S.I. Sanjay. The copies of same are annexed herewith as Annexure **R-5 & R-6** respectively for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.”

4. In view of above, no further order is warranted and the present petition stands disposed off.

5. Ordered accordingly.
