1. On 09.04.2024, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Through the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.47, dated 04.03.2024, under Sections 406/420 of IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra.

Reply dated 09.04.2024, by way of an affidavit of Mr. Om Parkash, DSP, Kurukshetra, has been filed, by the learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

In asking for the relief (supra), learned counsel for the petitioners mainly relies upon a compromise effected with the sole victim/complainant.

He further submits that the petitioner has filed a petition bearing No. CRM-M-17534-2024, seeking quashing of the instant FIR, on the basis of a compromise, in which learned counsel for the respondent, has caused appearance and pleaded no objection to quashing of the instant FIR.

At this stage, Mr. Samrat Jagat, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of the complainant, through a memo of appearance, and undertakes to file a validly executed power of attorney in his favour in the Registry of this Court.

In view of the above, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and on their doing so, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 14.05.2024.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-17534-2024.”

2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Tejbir, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and he has fully co-operated with the investigation process, and is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

4. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is **allowed**, and order dated 09.04.2024 is, hereby, made absolute, on the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
