1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.10 dated 07.02.2024, registered under Sections 323, 341, 325, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, Police Station Sadar, Sangrur submits that in compliance of order dated 03.04.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.
