GURBIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents Nos.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents Nos.4 to 7 and not to interfere in their personal lives.
2. It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 22.11.2003 while date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 21.01.2003. Copies of Aadhar Cards of petitioner Nos.1 & 2 to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively.
3. It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 09.02.2024. The marriage certificate is attached as Annexure P-3. Private respondents Nos.4 to 7 had opposed to their marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioner No.1 was earlier being illegally detained by her parents. Representation dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) was sent to SSP (UT), Chandigarh. Petitioner No.1 has joined the company of petitioner No.2. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 27.03.2024 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.2-Senior

Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

4. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3.
5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Vij, Additional PP, UT, Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter and in particular the legality of the alleged relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to forthwith consider the aforesaid representations dated 23.03.2024 and 27.03.2024 made on behalf of the petitioners and thereafter, take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners. Till then, protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. Respondent No.2 would pass necessary order within a period of one month without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.
7. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged relationship between the petitioners or protect them from legal action for violation, if any, committed by them.
