Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.15 dated 07.03.2024 registered under Sections 452, 341, 323, 506, 34 of the IPC (Sections 458 & 325 of the IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Mehal Kalan, District Barnala.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of Amandeep Kaur. It is alleged that she along with her family members were present at home with main gate open, when three young persons armed with weapons entered into the house. It is alleged that petitioner Deepak Singh dragged the brother of the complainant Karanpreet Singh and then co-accused Jaskaran Singh gave iron rod blow on left arm of her brother.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only role attributed to the petitioner is to have pulled the brother of the complainant i.e. Karanpreet Singh and that there was no motive.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and going through the contents of the FIR, this Court does not find the present case to be fit for grant of anticipatory bail having regard to the role attributed to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
