The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the order dated 22.04.2004 (Annexure P-10), whereby the petitioner has been reverted from the post of Assistant General Manager to Senior Manager.

2. On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:-

"Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as while issuing notice of motion on 04.05.2004, the operation of the impugned order dated 22.04.2004 (Annexure P-10) was stayed and thereafter, the petitioner has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.03.2006 as Assistant General Manager and the same fact has been recorded in the order dated 29.08.2024 passed in CWP-8696-2004 titled as Punjab State Cooperative Bank Versus State of Punjab and others, wherein, the present petitioner



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was respondent No.3.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks time to get instructions.

On her request, adjourned to 21.10.2024."

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite her best efforts, she has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.
- 4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
