RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 26.07.2023 passed in CWP-19861-2017.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Ranbir Singh Deshwal, Executive Engineer, City Division UHBVN, Sonapat, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 26.07.2023 passed in CWP-19861-2017 has been complied with and necessary payments have been made to the petitioner, as would decipher from the cash vouchers (Annexures R-1 and R-2).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
