The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.19 dated 14.02.2024 under Sections 394, 34 IPC and Section 411 and 379B IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station nangal, District Rupnagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 16.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
