1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 18.12.2023 passed in CWP-14589-2005.

2. Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.2 has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

3. Mr. H.S. Oberoi, Advocate and Ms. Anmolpreet Kaur, Advocate put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 and filed power of attorney and has also filed short affidavit of respondent No.3. The same are taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents-State has submitted that the order dated 18.12.2023 passed in CWP-14589-2005 has been complied with and necessary instructions have been issued to respondent No.3-Accountant General to release the amount to the petitioner, subject to outcome of LPA No.1466 of 2024 filed by the respondents.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.



6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
