NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* to pay the retiral dues of the petitioner, including leave encashment, after fixing the pay of the petitioner by granting due annual increments and pay scale in view of 6th Pay Commission.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset confines her prayer for deciding representation dated 30.12.2023 (Annexure P-12). She submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and Mr. Manbir Singh, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 30.12.2023 (Annexure P-12) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled, necessary benefits be released within a period of three weeks thereafter.
7. The petition stands disposed of.
