The instant petition was filed way back seeking quashing of order dated 07.02.2013 vide which the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 02.07.2024, none had put in an appearance on behalf of the petitioner, as a result of which the Registry had been directed to intimate learned counsel for the petitioner about the adjourned date. Even earlier thereto, vide order dated 02.09.2022 notice had been issued to the petitioner, since none had put in an appearance on his behalf.

As per the office report, learned counsel for the petitioner was duly intimated about the adjourned date. However, yet again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand, has informed the Court, on instructions, that the petitioner is still a proclaimed offender.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
