The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside order dated 27.11.1996 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner (Relief and Resettlement), Punjab; *Naysha Jeem* dated 03.10.1986 (Annexure P-6); order dated 30.10.1986 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, First Grade, Gurdaspur and order dated 17.11.1987 (Annexure P-9) passed by the learned Collector, Gurdaspur.

2. A perusal of file reveals that on the last date of hearing

(23.04.2024), the following order was passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“It has been brought to the notice of the Court that Mr. Amarjit Markan, Advocate appearing for the petitioner has expired.

Let notice be issued to the petitioner for 10.09.2024.”

3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that *“the petitioner not found, as the village is very large and his house was not traceable.”*

4. Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
