NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the part of impugned order dated 31.08.2023 (Annexure P-15) and a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the basic pension of the petitioner and to pay the consequential arrears w.e.f. 01.01.2016 to 30.11.2021; to pay and release the withheld additional pension amount (Old Age Allowance) along with usual D.A. w.e.f. 01.09.2023 onwards and to pay and release the bi-annually LTC amount due since December, 2022 along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for

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the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a detailed representation to the Competent Authority for redressal of his grievances as have been raised in the present petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
4. However, if any such representation is submitted by the petitioner within a period of one week, the same shall be considered by the Competent Authority, in accordance with law, within a period of two months thereafter.
