The prayer in the present Civil Writ Petitions filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is to issue a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing Annexure P-8 and regularize the services of the petitioners being similarly situated to Sukhdev Kaur, who was also working as a Part Time Sweeper in Govt. Primary School Matti in District Mansa, which was allowed by this Court, against which the SLP was dismissed. The petitioners were also engaged as a Part Time Sweeper.

3. In view of the aforesaid, these petitions are hereby disposed of, reserving the petitioners with a liberty to revive the same, in case need arises.
