By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0070 dated 28.02.2024 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 506 IPC (later on added Section 307 IPC without doctor opinion) at Police Station Urban Estate, Rohtak, District Rohtak, Haryana.

As per allegations, on 27.02.2024, petitioner along with co-accused Ashish, Satish alias Kala, Sahil, Priyanshu and two others, armed with weapons caused injuries to complainant with Batons and as many as four injuries were caused on his person including on the head.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated; there is no opinion regarding the injury attracting Section 307 IPC nor any medical opinion has been taken in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

Learned State Counsel submits that entire occurrence was captured on the CCTV footage which corroborated the complainant's version.

After hearing both the sides, this Court does not find the present case to be fit for grant of anticipatory having regard to attribution to the petitioner as he participated in the crime along with the co-accused.

Dismissed.
