VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondent no.1 has submitted that the issue in the present case is with respect to the correct date of birth of respondent no.1 and since stay has been granted by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 02.05.2000, learned counsel in order to know about the latest position had sent a registered notice to respondent no.1 and in response to the said registered letter, it has been endorsed that respondent no.1 has died. A copy of the said registered notice along with endorsement is taken on record as Mark 'A'.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that since the operation of the judgments of the trial Court as well as of the appellate Court have been stayed and since during the pendency of the present appeal, respondent no.1 has died and in all probability has received all retiral benefits, thus, the present appeal, apparently, has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such and liberty be granted to the parties to revive the same, in case, any cause survives.
3. In view of the above, the present appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the appellant and LR's of respondent no.1 to revive the case, in case, any cause survives.
