Present applications have been filed by the applicant-respondent No.3 under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, for seeking preponement of the date of hearing in the main writ petitions which are stated to be listed for hearing on 28.08.2024.

Notice in the applications to the counsel opposite had been issued on 07.05.2024, however, no reply has been filed.

Learned counsel appearing for the non-applicants/petitioner(s) submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid application being allowed.

Accordingly, both the applications are allowed. The date of hearing is preponed from 28.08.2024 and both the writ petitions are taken on board for hearing today itself.

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Main cases

The present order shall dispose of the above noted two writ petitions as they have been filed challenging the common order.

Challenge in the present writ petitions was to the order passed against the petitioners who were removed from the post of Executive Board Member, General Secretary, Joint Secretary, Junior Vice President and Member Executive Board of the Haryana Sikh Gurudwara Management Committee.

Learned counsel for the respondents contend that the Committee in question had been constituted for a period of 18 months and that the said period has already come to an end on 21.05.2024.

Since the tenure of the Committee was for a period of 18 months and the said tenure has already come to an end, the present petitions are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Needless to mention that in the event of the term of the said Committee having been extended by any subsequent order passed by the competent Authority, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present writ petition.

Pending, misc. application(s), if any shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
