In the present petition, the only question raised at the time of hearing is that the petitioner had applied for the Review Medical Board so as to ascertain whether, the petitioner is entitled for the conveyance allowance or not but the respondents are not deciding the same which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in case any representation has been received from the petitioner causing constitution of the Review Medical Board so as to ascertain whether the petitioner is entitled for the conveyance allowance or not, appropriate order will be passed within a period of four weeks of the receipt of the copy of this order and in case it is found feasible to direct the constitution of the Review Medical Board, the same will be done otherwise due reason will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner while passing the speaking order.
