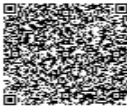

1. The applicant has moved moved the present application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condoning the delay of 208 days in filing the present application for grant of special leave to appeal before this Court.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is a poor person and due to paucity of funds, he could not file the application for grant of special leave to appeal within the period of limitation, however, later on, he arranged the funds from his friends and relatives and presented application for grant of special leave to appeal before this Court. Thus, a delay of 208 days in filing the application for grant of special leave to appeal had occurred.

3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant and perused the record carefully.

4. From the averments made in the application, it is apparent that the applicant has not mentioned his profession/avocation in life. Even, no averments made in the application with regard to the financial status of the applicant and no documentary evidence has been annexed with the application. Only vague averments have been made in the application that due to paucity of funds, the applicant could not file the application for grant of special leave to appeal within the period of limitation. Even, no reasonable explanation has been offered by the applicant in the application and finding no substance, the application is ordered to be dismissed.

1. Since, the application for condonation of delay in filing the application for grant of special leave to appeal has been ordered to be dismissed, no separate orders are required to be passed in the main case.

2. The application for special leave to appeal is, accordingly, dismissed.
