The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing G.D. No.005 dated 29.10.2023 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 307, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Samrala, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana in cross case bearing FIR No.233 dated 29.10.2023 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 307, 427, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.04.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 03.04.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
