The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.168 dated 22.11.2023, under Sections 307, 365, 342, 323, 148 and 149 of the IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 325/326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

This Court vide order dated 16.04.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 16.04.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 16.04.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
