NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned notices/orders dated 21.01.2004 (Annexure P-2) and dated 05.12.2003 (Annexure P-1) and for restraining the respondents from re-fixing the pay of the petitioner w.e.f. 25.01.1993 and also from making recovery of the amount in question from him.

2. While issuing notice of motion on 18.05.2004, operation of the impugned orders dated 21.01.2004 (Annexure P-2) & 05.12.2003 (Annexure P-1), was stayed.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has unfortunately died on 02.04.2010 and the wife of the petitioner is getting family pension.



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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions from the LRs of the petitioner.
5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the LRs of the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
