GURBIR SINGH, J.(Oral)

1. Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his wife at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6. Petitioner has also prayed for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to consider his representation dated 23.02.2024 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned State counsel, while referring to short reply filed by way of affidavit dated 25.04.2024 of Surinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central Amritsar, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, already on record, submits that the dispute is between family members with regard to land and so far as protection of life and liberty of petitioner

and his wife is concerned, they do not have any such apprehension. The reply further suggests that directions have been issued to the SHO, Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar, to keep a close and constant watch on both the parties in order to thwart any untoward incident in future and to ensure protection of the petitioner and his wife.

3. In view of above reply, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of present petition with liberty file fresh one in case the petitioner feels any such apprehension.

4. Allowed, as prayed for.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
