- On 22.01.2024, the following order was passed:

“CM-793-CWP-2024

The applicant through instant application is seeking permission to implead legal heirs of the deceased petitioner. The applicant is further seeking permission to file amended memo of parties.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed. Amended memo of party is taken on record. Let the Legal Representatives of the Balwinder Singh (deceased), be substituted in his place.

Registry is directed to carry out necessary amendment.

Application stands disposed of.”
- On 15.04.2024, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and State sought time to get instructions.
- Learned State counsel submits that as per his instructions petitioner-Balwinder Singh has passed away.
- The petitioner was SPO and he was dismissed from service

by order dated 13.08.2001. He has passed away during the pendency of present petition. He was not holding a permanent post as post of SPO is a temporary post. He was not governed by either Punjab Police Rules, 1934 or Punjab Civil Service Rules. On account of his death, he cannot be reinstated and he, during the past period has not served, thus, he or his family members cannot be paid salary.

4. In such circumstances, the present petition deserves to be dismissed and accordingly dismissed.

5. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
