1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.6 dated 07.03.2024, under Section 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Patara, District Jalandhar.

2. Vide detailed order dated 05.04.2024, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the police by this Court.

3. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has already joined investigation with the police.

4. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner.

5. Counsel for the complainant submits that the present petition

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be disposed of in accordance with law.

6. Admittedly, the petitioner is real brother of the complainant and there is dispute between the parties with regard to theft of certain articles belonging to the complainant which were lying in the property jointly owned by them.

7. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and interim order dated 05.04.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner is to abide by the conditions as are provided in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and to join further investigation as and when called to do so by the police in the present case.
