1. This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the official respondents to take action on the representation dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-1), moved to respondent No. 2.
2. Heard.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner, who is a doctor by profession, aged about 72 years, feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents No. 4 to 7, had moved a representation dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) before

the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City, Amritsar, but no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in fact the private respondents had filed a false complaint against the petitioner earlier also which was disposed of vide inquiry report dated 25.04.2022 (Annexure P-2) and 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-3) by the Board of Doctors, Office of the Civil Surgeon, Amritsar.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-1) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

6. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

7. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-1) will be disposed of in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

8. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2 - the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City,

Amritsar, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-1), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

9. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
