1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioners were appointed during the Covid but thereafter, the services of the petitioners were terminated and now, similarly situated employees have already been adjusted in the other department, which benefit has not been extended to the petitioners such act on the part of respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 04.05.2023 and 22.07.2023, a copy of which has been attached as Annexure P-5 and Annexure P-6 respectively, and the petitioner will be satisfied in case, directions are issued to the respondent to decide the same, while passing appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in case the representation dated 04.05.2023 and 22.07.2023 a copy of which has been

appended as Anneuxre P-5 and Annexure P-6 respectively, are still pending consideration with the department concerned, appropriate speaking order will be passed and in case it is found feasible to grant relief to the petitioners as claimed in those representations, the same will be extended to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim and will be conveyed to the petitioners.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel no other grievance of the petitioner survived at this stage. The present petition may kindly be disposed of as having being not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
