1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) moved to respondents No.2 and 3 respectively in accordance with law.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondent No. 5, the petitioner has moved the representation dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-2), but till date, no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
