Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents No.1 and 2 to release pending payment of Rs.7,61,974/- on account of works done by the petitioner in limits of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad at Ward No. 37, Division No. IV of Ballabgarh alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has served legal notice dated 07.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) upon respondent-authorities, however, they have not released the amount in question.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1.

Mr. Vivek Saini, who is the Additional Advocate General Haryana and would thus be on the panel of all statutory Board and Corporations of the State of Haryana has been requested to accept notice on behalf of the respondents No. 2 to 6-Municipal Corporation, Faridabad.

On the asking of the Court, he accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 6-Municipal Corporation, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.3- Superintendent Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad is directed to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 07.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

The learned State Counsel does not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 07.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said legal notice, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
