The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.112 dated 26.02.2024 under Sections 120-B, 406 IPC registered at Police Station City Ballabhgarh, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

The learned counsel for the petitioner No.2-Divya submits that pursuant to the orders dated 31.05.2024 and 24.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 31.05.2024 and 24.07.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 31.05.2024 is made absolute with regard to petitioner No.2 only.

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However, the petitioner No.2-Divya shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
