The present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of direction to learned Family Court, to expeditiously dispose of the contempt petition, filed against the respondent, for continued wilful disobedience of the interim order dated 25.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) and also to decide the application under Section 12 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1860, for monthly overnight custody of the child, more particularly, while considering the upcoming birthday of the child on 06.05.2024.

On query by the Court, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the date fixed by learned Family Court, on the application under Section 12 of the Guardians and Wards Act, is in the month of July, 2024. However, an application for early hearing has been filed, which is now fixed for 03.05.2024.

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Considering the aforesaid fact situation, learned Family Court is hereby requested to consider and dispose of the application, which is fixed for 03.05.2024, in the fitness of circumstances and in accordance with law. However, no such time bound direction can be given, with regard to disposal of the contempt petition. But anyhow, learned Family Court is requested to sensitize itself, with regard to handling of the family matters and dispose of the present case, in accordance with the instructions issued by this Court, from time to time.

In view of the aforesaid, the instant revision petition stands disposed of.
